SUBJECT: SUMMER ATHLETICS AND CHEER GUIDELINES - UPDATE

The following information regarding summer athletics and cheer guidelines is effective June 15, 2021.

The information stated in this document are meant to serve as clarifying guidance regarding face-covering / mask-wearing during summer athletics and cheer conditioning/practices. Additionally, the purpose of this information is to align our district COVID practices with the <u>CDPH guidelines released on June 15, 2021</u>.

Mask Guidelines

- The CDPH <u>Guidance for the Use of Face Coverings</u> applies to all Californians and must be followed.
- All athletes participating in *indoor sports* are to wear face coverings when participating, even with heavy exertion <u>as tolerated</u>, and as prescribed in the CIF <u>sport-specific guidelines</u> (regardless of CIF affiliation) with the following modifications:
 - ✓ When not actively participating in play, masks are required, *for indoor sports*, by all participants, coaches, assistants, observers, etc. This includes athletes on the bench, sidelines, etc., unless prohibited by activities such as drinking water or receiving care.
 - ✓ Masks can be removed at any time for an athlete to catch his or her breath during or after heavy exertion.
 - ✓ Masks are not required for outdoor sports activities.
 - ✓ Wherever possible, physical distancing of six feet should be achieved before removing masks and should be replaced as soon as safe to do so.
- Observers or spectators attending an indoor event, game, or practice are to wear a mask.

Indoor Activities Guidelines

- Athletes and coaches can use their school gym, weight room(s), or wrestling practice room.
- Masks are to be worn for all indoor activities (see above guidelines for masks).
- o Coaches will have to ensure physical distance, continue to sanitize the equipment after use and reduce any potential crowding pending the size of the gym, weight, or wrestling room(s).

Outdoor Activities Guidelines

- Masks are not required for outdoor sports activities.
- Coaches will have to ensure physical distance, continue to sanitize the equipment after use, and reduce any potential crowding pending the size of the area/field they are using.

Observers/Spectators Guidelines

- Observes or spectators may attend indoor events, practices, and games.
- Masks are required to be worn for all indoor activities (see above guidelines for masks).
- There is no limit to the total number of observers or spectators at an event under 5000 people.
- School administration and coaches are to continue to ensure physical distance and reduce any potential crowding.

- Athletic team travel to events/games outside of the county or state is allowed.
- All other MCS COVID protocols for athletics and cheer continue.
