Program Description:

In the spring of 1993, Modesto High School made application to the International Baccalaureate Office (IBO) in Geneva, Switzerland, to affiliate with them and to receive approval to offer courses leading to an IB Diploma. The IB Diploma is awarded by the IBO to students who successfully sit for external examinations in six academic subject areas, complete a course of study in the Theory of Knowledge, compose an extended essay reflecting their own independent research and analysis, and complete 150 hours of service to the community.

Course requirements for the IB Diploma are aligned with the entrance requirements of the best universities throughout the world and are designed to encourage a universal education. Since its beginnings in 1967, the IB program has grown into a significant global educational force in more than 90 countries. A measure of the success of the IB program at Modesto High is its recognition by such notable and prestigious institutions as Harvard, Yale, Stanford, MIT, Northwestern, USC, UC Berkeley, and UCLA.

The IB program provides highly motivated college-bound students with the opportunity to pursue a rigorous liberal arts curriculum. The program will meet the needs of students in grades 9 through 12 from all schools in Modesto and surrounding communities. Students enrolled in the program will participate in extra-curricular and athletic activities on the Modesto High School campus.

International Baccalaureate is a four-year course of study in two phases: Pre-IB for grades 9 and 10, and IB curriculum for grades 11 and 12.

Curriculum:

The Preliminary International Baccalaureate (Pre-IB) program is an intense two-year academic experience at the ninth and tenth grade levels that prepares students for the rigors of the International Baccalaureate (IB) program. General program guides, standards, and final exams for the IB diploma are designed and monitored by the IB offices in Geneva, Switzerland, and Cardiff, Wales, United Kingdom.
