What would assist you with the transition to Jr. High or High School?

- Shadow a Jr. High or HS student for one day the year preceding attendance
- Add more teachers at the 6th grade level that specialize in one subject so students can begin working with more than one teacher during the day.

What can a District do to encourage students to attend school each day?

- Have more field trips to make learning exciting- 8th grade & leadership classes should visit Sacramento capital to learn about government
- Pay students to attend
- Have more activities for jr. high students to do afterschool
- Give students the full week of Thanksgiving off so families can travel

What can we do to improve school for students?

- Better cafeteria food
- Provide a morning snack bar for students
- Provide vending machines so students can get something when hungry
- Provide 1:1 digital textbooks/computers

What can a school do to help struggling students?

- Allow students to work with other students on projects/homework etc.
- Have a student resource page on the District web page that provides links to resources for homework help.
- Add an additional period to the school day so students can do homework (study hall)
- Provide additional opportunities for extended summer school so students can retake classes they failed
- Block scheduling would reduce the number of teachers assigning work each day

What can schools do to increase parent involvement?

- Feed parents when there is a meeting
- Provide alternative times for the same meeting (morning, afternoon and evening)
