- Make up credit for freshmen failing the first semester
- Full-time counselors
- Tutors for each subject
- Tutoring Centers at all the schools

- Have teacher variability at tutoring sessions
- Peer counseling, as some problems may have resulted from poor home life
- Haven for students
- Connect MCS to the Center of Human Services
