

MVA Transitional Kindergarten

Purpose: To provide distance learning opportunities for Transitional Kindergarten students.

Overview: This course is aligned with the sequence of instruction students would receive if they attended the physical classroom. It focuses on essential standards for early literacy and mathematics. The instructional resources are provided through Schoology. Students and parents will access the content via links on a web site. These resources are designed to support parents in guiding the instruction. Web links to nursery rhymes and stories are provided to support families without print material, however parents are encouraged to read books and sing with their child to support oral language and comprehension skills that are vital in early education. Training: It is highly recommended that any parent of a TK student attend training. Parent training will be offered to guide parents in understanding the resources, routines and goals of transitional kindergarten.

Schedule: Each day consists of approximately 2 hours of instruction in literacy, math, and physical movement. Additionally parents will be offered suggested activities for creative time and social-emotional learning opportunities.
