Amy Elliott Neumann was first elected to the Board of Education in November 2011 as a trustee at large and was re-elected in November 2015. Ms. Neumann served as president of the Board in 2014–2015, and again in 2017–2018. As a member of the Board, she was appointed to the Schools Infra-structure Financing Agency (SIFA) in 2012, where she serves as Vice Chairperson. Ms. Neumann was instrumental in drafting the Board's first set of comprehensive Board Protocols.

Ms. Neumann is a practicing civil attorney in Modesto. She is a Beyer High School graduate and she holds a bachelor's degree in Political Economy from the University of California, Berkeley. She obtained her juris doctor from The Ohio State University College of Law.

Ms. Neumann is an active member of our community. She served as Chairperson for the City of Modesto Board of Zoning Adjustment from 2006 through 2011. She then was appointed to the City of Modesto Planning Commission, where she served until her election to the Modesto City Schools Board in November 2011. Ms. Neumann served as a member of the Education Foundation of Stanislaus County, Modesto Junior College Foundation, Lighthouse Preschool Board of Directors, Parent Resource Center, and City of Modesto Charter Review Committee. She currently serves on the University of California, Merced Foundation Board.
