In looking at the LCAP 2017-2018 "Needs," how is Goal #1 being met at your campus?

Consider: Future Ready, School Facilities, Parent Involvement, School Safety

- Focus on Freshmen and seniors
- More computers/Schoology (one to one)
- Continue TLC (Tutoring Learning Center @ Beyer)
- More Gregori tutoring programs
- Libraries – keep them open later
- SBO (Student Body Office) use before and during school
- Spread the AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) program (2)
- Teen parenting class
- Interactive teaching / involved teachers
- Business class/financial math
- ROP – provide rides
- Enough sports facilities
- Lack of toilet paper (2)
- More counselors
- No bathroom passes / more freedom
- AC (Air Conditioning) in gyms

Goal 2: Increase student achievement to ensure each student demonstrates success with State Standards and be College and Career Ready.

In looking at the LCAP 2017-2018 “Needs,” how is Goal #2 being met at your campus?

Consider: Career & Life Skills (Career pathways, vocational programs, careers software (grades 1-6)), Progress Towards Graduation, College Readiness (IB, AP AVID, A-G), Career Readiness

- The AP (Advanced Placement) waiver is successful to make available to students – the gap is drastic
- More counselors
- Mental health specialists need to be made more available
- College counselors need to be made more available to all grades, not just seniors, they need support from before junior year
- ROP programs / IB (International Baccalaureate) – successful, although sometimes incentive isn't enough for them to miss other classes – we need counselor to make students more aware from before so students can organize their schedule
- OVERALL – communication needs to be increased and technology has been effective as a tool
- Technology, implementing the 1 to 1 device has been effective to make resources available
- Having SAT prep books in the library is effective
- Opportunities need to be made for students before their senior year
- Opportunities are emphasized for upperclassmen, making underclassmen feel like they do not have to do it
- There needs to be an increase of communication between parents
- Students are often unaware of opportunities, if there are any
- Students feel like they need more recognition

Consider: Academic Support (tutoring, support classes, summer school, etc.), Counseling (guidance, college, social/emotional, etc.), Mentors, Extra-Curriculars

- Not enough knowledge of SAT / college readiness
- Teachers should be more educated on what to inform students with and how to help
- Lack of communication to all student body
- Not public programs to make students feel welcomed
- Need more unity throughout schools
- Improvement of staff
- Better strategies of teaching
- Possibly increased amount of teacher training
- More publicity of before / after school
- Easy for students to access
- More knowledge of credit recovery / on track / college readiness
- Reminder system / publicity of college readiness / high school requirements
- Better education of nurse / nurse's office
- More readiness for next four years

What other actions can be taken to support the 2017-2018 “Needs” in Goal #3?

- Press of certain information from teachers to students
- Possibly a different approach to pushing kids to want to graduate
- College readiness classes / assemblies
- More kids should have opportunity to go to 6th grade camp
- More publication of extra-curriculars
- Possibly more counselors / specialized in certain situations
- Uniform tutoring
- SAT prep information
