Goal 1: Provide facilities that are safe and welcoming to enhance and maximize learning opportunities.

In looking at the LCAP 2017-2018 “Needs,” how is Goal #1 being met at your campus?

Consider: Future Ready, School Facilities, Parent Involvement, School Safety

- Outside eating area is nice
- Overall everything is good

What other actions can be taken to support the 2017-2018 “Needs” in Goal #1?

- Better locks on bathroom doors
- Better food in cafeteria – more options
- More activities at lunchtime
- More room outside of cafeteria to eat outside – lines too long
- Water tastes like chlorine sometimes
- Room on water fountains to fill water bottles
- Some potholes filled
- Need tetherball court(s)
- More variety of books in the library

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Goal 2: Increase student achievement to ensure each student demonstrates success with State Standards and be College and Career Ready.

In looking at the LCAP 2017-2018 “Needs,” how is Goal #2 being met at your campus?

Consider: Career & Life Skills (Career pathways, vocational programs, careers software (grades 1-6)), Progress Towards Graduation, College Readiness (IB, AP AVID, A-G), Career Readiness

- Sometimes devices are slow – lots of updates
- Maybe devices not shut down
- Better internet (faster)
- Use computers a lot – depends on the teacher (1-2 classes per day)
- Computers can help you in the future for careers
- Easy – use google to get information for projects

Parent Communication

What other actions can be taken to support the 2017-2018 “Needs” in Goal #2?

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Goal 3: Support students' academic and social success by providing access to remediation and enrichment opportunities and promoting positive well-being.

In looking at the LCAP 2017-2018 "Needs," how is Goal #3 being met at your campus?

Consider: Academic Support (tutoring, support classes, summer school, etc.), Counseling (guidance, college, social/emotional, etc.), Mentors, Extra-Curriculars

- What would help students who get into trouble?
- Kids that don't get along should have different schedules
- More security – campus supervision by more areas (cafeteria, bathrooms)
- High school students beating up other students after school
- Have more positive things to do to keep students engaged, especially at lunch
- Need more campus supervisors
- Kids making fun of sexuality
- Need more security in front of school

What other actions can be taken to support the 2017-2018 “Needs” in Goal #3?

- Sometimes we are in the wrong class, need to have an assessment to place students, especially in math
- Sometimes when you are absent teachers don't give you make up work and your grade goes down
- We need to get extra credit opportunities
- Trio sometimes after school – application process
- Changing schedule is hard, especially going from regular class to honors
- Everyone wants to go to college

- Learning math & ELA – How can we help them?
