

## **LCAP Feedback 2017-2018**

**Goal 1: Provide facilities that are safe and welcoming to enhance and maximize learning opportunities.**

In looking at the LCAP 2017-2018 “Needs,” how is Goal #1 being met at your campus?

Consider: Future Ready, School Facilities, Parent Involvement, School Safety

- Two theaters
- Two gyms / soccer fields / baseball fields
- Auto shop
- Devices have Adobe products
- PPT availability
- Just having the device is more convenient
- Devices improve communication with teachers
- Provides equity
- ELA curriculum is challenging
- ELA curriculum is interdisciplinary
- Feel safe on campus

What other actions can be taken to support the 2017-2018 “Needs” in Goal #1?

- Restrooms – not enough, especially the north campus
- Restrooms, mirrors are scratched
- North campus bathrooms are small
- Dirty carpets, room 102 is lifted up
- Access to temperature controls
- Need a dedicated spot for custodial supplies
- Square sheet toilet paper or ½ ply toilet paper
- Not enough soap dispensers
- Out of soap often
- Black box, theater/classroom risers are not cleaned
- Lunch lines are hard to maneuver
- Water damage in ceilings (chemistry class)
- Auto shop cold – no AC/Heat
- WiFi down often
- Concerns with saving documents
- Harder to focus when using device
- Not as much interaction with teachers
- When system down, teachers don’t know what to do
- Students are just learning to use devices/programs
- Some students don’t have WiFi access
- Need to enforce dress code more
- Dress code seems one sided towards girls only
- Counselors don’t meet with every student or give bad info
- Counselors should check in more
- Staff should listen to students, not just parents
- Need more advance notice of events
- Multiple calls on the same topic is annoying
- Certain applications are blocked
- More access to counselors is needed

**Goal 2: Increase student achievement to ensure each student demonstrates success with State Standards and be College and Career Ready.**

In looking at the LCAP 2017-2018 “Needs,” how is Goal #2 being met at your campus?

Consider: Career & Life Skills (Career pathways, vocational programs, careers software (grades 1-6)), Progress Towards Graduation, College Readiness (IB, AP AVID, A-G), Career Readiness

- Afterschool program – TRIO offers tutoring

What other actions can be taken to support the 2017-2018 “Needs” in Goal #2?

- Tutoring should be more available
- Financial math instruction needs improvement
- All classes need more instructional support
- Need more class options like calculus (not IB calculus)
- Teacher accidentally deleted students note
- In math, when graphing on device, it's difficult to test on paper
- Offer more than one college fair
- More opportunities to talk with colleges needed

## LCAP Feedback 2017-2018

**Goal 3: Support students' academic and social success by providing access to remediation and enrichment opportunities and promoting positive well-being.**

In looking at the LCAP 2017-2018 "Needs," how is Goal #3 being met at your campus?

Consider: Academic Support (tutoring, support classes, summer school, etc.), Counseling (guidance, college, social/emotional, etc.), Mentors, Extra-Curriculars

- English Learners had a lot of support learning English

What other actions can be taken to support the 2017-2018 “Needs” in Goal #3?

- English Learners need more Spanish speaking teachers at lower levels
- Offer more foreign languages
- More tools for drama department (trailers/carts to carry equipment)
- Add a football field (use golf course)
- Auto shop class is small – needs different furniture
- Boys sports get more attention/funding/equipment
- More LGBTQ training/acceptance for students and staff
- Need snacks available for Extended Summer School
